Section 1. STATE TRAFFIC LAWS ADOPTED.

(A) Except as otherwise specifically provided in this Code, all statutory provisions in Chs. 340 to 348, Wis. Stats., describing and defining regulations with respect to vehicles and traffic for which the penalty is a forfeiture only, including penalties to be imposed and procedure for prosecution, exclusive of any regulations for which the statutory penalty is a term of imprisonment, are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this article as if fully set forth herein. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by any statute incorporated herein by reference is required or prohibited by this chapter. Any future amendments, revisions or modifications of the statutory regulations in Chs. 340 to 348 incorporated herein are intended to be made part of this Chapter in order to secure, to the extent legally practicable, uniform statewide regulation of vehicles and vehicle traffic on highways, streets, and alleys of the State of Wisconsin.

(B) **Other state laws adopted.** There are also hereby adopted by reference the following sections of Wisconsin statutes, but the prosecution of such offenses under this article shall be provided in Wis. Stats. 340 through 348, and the penalty for violation thereof shall be limited to a forfeiture as hereinafter provided in this article: - Wis. Stats., 350.01 through 350.19, Snowmobiles, /// ss. TR101.02 (2), Unnecessary Acceleration, ss. 23.33 (2)(a) through 23.33 (12)(b), All Terrain Vehicles. Wis. Adm. Code - Trans 305, Standards for Motor Vehicle Equipment.
