

Ordinance to enact Code of Ordinances

The Town Board of the Town of Edgewater, Sawyer County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1 – TITLE/PURPOSE

The title of this ordinance is the Town of Edgewater Ordinance to Enact Code of Ordinances so as to meet the publication requirements of WI Stats §§ 59.14, 60.80, 61.50(1) and 62.11 (4)(a).

SECTION 2 – AUTHORITY

The Town Board of the Town of Edgewater has the specific authority, powers and duties pursuant to WI Stats. § 66.0103 to prepare a code of some or all of its general ordinances by enacting an ordinance that incorporates the code by reference.

SECTION 3 – ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE

The Town Board of the Town of Edgewater has, by adoption of this ordinance, provided the authority for the Town of Edgewater to prepare and enact a code of its general ordinances.

SECTION 4 – ENACTMENT AND INCORPORATION OF CODE OF ORDINANCES

The code of ordinances in book form entitled "Town of Edgewater Ordinances," having been placed on file and open to public inspection in both the Town Hall and in the office of the Town Clerk for a period of two (2) weeks commencing 9/24, 2008, pursuant to WI Stats. § 66.0103, is adopted as the general code of ordinances in and for the Town of Edgewater, Sawyer County, Wisconsin. The code is incorporated in the ordinance by reference.

SECTION 5 – TOWN CLERK TO MAINTAIN COPIES OF DOCUMENTS INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE

Whenever any general code, rule, regulation, statute or other written or printed matter is adopted by reference, it shall be deemed incorporated in this Code as if fully set forth herein, and the Town Clerk shall maintain in the office a copy of any such material as adopted and as amended from time to time or have access to such material on the Internet Town Website. Materials on file at the Town Clerk's office shall be considered public records open to reasonable examination by any person during the office hours of the Town Clerk subject to such restrictions on examination as the Clerk imposes for the preservation of the material. All requests shall be made in writing and shall allow ten (10) days notice for time of examination.

SECTION 6 – EFFECTIVE DATE

Following passage by the Edgewater Town Board, this ordinance is effective on publication or posting, as required under WI Stats. § 60.80.
