The Green Lake – Sis Silent Sport Trail continues to get a lot of use from Edgewater Residents and Visitors alike. All Trails are now Color Coded with new Signage and new enlarged Trail Maps at each Trail Intersection. Even with a summer of downed trees from storms, volunteers have been able to keep the trails in good hiking condition including mowing several times during the summer to provide for easy hiking for all ages.

Enjoy the beautiful north woods experience & take a family hike through some of the most pristine forests in Edgewater. Trail Head parking lots are located 2 miles north of County F on Little Sissabagama Road or 1.3 miles north of County Hwy F on Green Lake Road.
